  - a) <u>Stephen Hands Path Wainscott Public Water Supply Facility Negative</u> <u>Declaration and Easement Substitution</u> Declare the Authority as Lead Agent for the purposes of the SEQRA (State Environmental Quality Review Act) review and adopt the Negative Declaration regarding the Stephen Hands Path Wainscott Public Water Supply Facility; and authorize the CEO to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate the easement substitution.
- 7. <u>Property Casualty Insurance</u>
  - a) Renew policy with Starr Indemnity Ace American Insurance Company at a cost of \$197,728.
    - i. Renew broker service agreement with Willis Towers Watson, Willis of New York, Inc. at a fee of \$19,000.
  - b) <u>General Liability, Auto and Lead Umbrella (\$10,000,000)</u> Renew the above policies from Allied World Assurance Company at a cost of \$288,983.
  - c) <u>Excess/Umbrella Liability</u> 2<sup>nd</sup> Layer, Coverage limit \$15 million limit: Purchase new with Great American Insurance Company at a cost of \$65,000.
    3<sup>rd</sup> Layer \$25 million limit: Purchase new from XL Insurance Company at a cost of \$50,000.

Renew with Travelers with Willis Towers Watson acting as broker who will receive a commission on this line of coverage rather than a fee from the Authority. The premium, including commission is \$11,658.

h) Cyber Insurance

Purchase new a Cyber Insurance policy through Willis Towers Watson and issued by the Beazley Insurance Company. The premium, including commission, is \$18,606.

- i) <u>Surety Street Opening Permit Bonds</u> Renew with Hartford In. Co. with Willis Towers Watson, Willis of New York, Inc. acting as broker on a commission basis. The approximate cost is \$4,800.
- j) Authorize the Risk Management Department, in consultation with the CEO and General Counsel, to be authorized to recommend settlements to our insurers on claims that occur between April 1, 2018 through March 31, 2019 and that fall within the policy retention or deductible limits.

  - c) Enter into an agreement with Arthur J. Gallagher & Company, located at One Jericho Plaza, Suite 200, Jericho, NY, for insurance broker services relating to the purchase and servicing the excess insurance policy during the one-year period beginning April 1, 2018, at a cost of \$12,500.
  - d) Authorize the CEO in conjunction with General Counsel and the Risk Management Department to implement an Authority Safety, Human Resources and Risk Management Assessment with PMA Management Corp. at an amount not to exceed \$20,000.
