CONTRACTS – EXTEND

2. Contract 7269 – for furnishing and delivery of butterfly valves and operator replacement pumps (Items 1-7, 10-18), during the one-year period beginning October 1, 2017 – extend with Raritan Valve & Automation, Inc.
